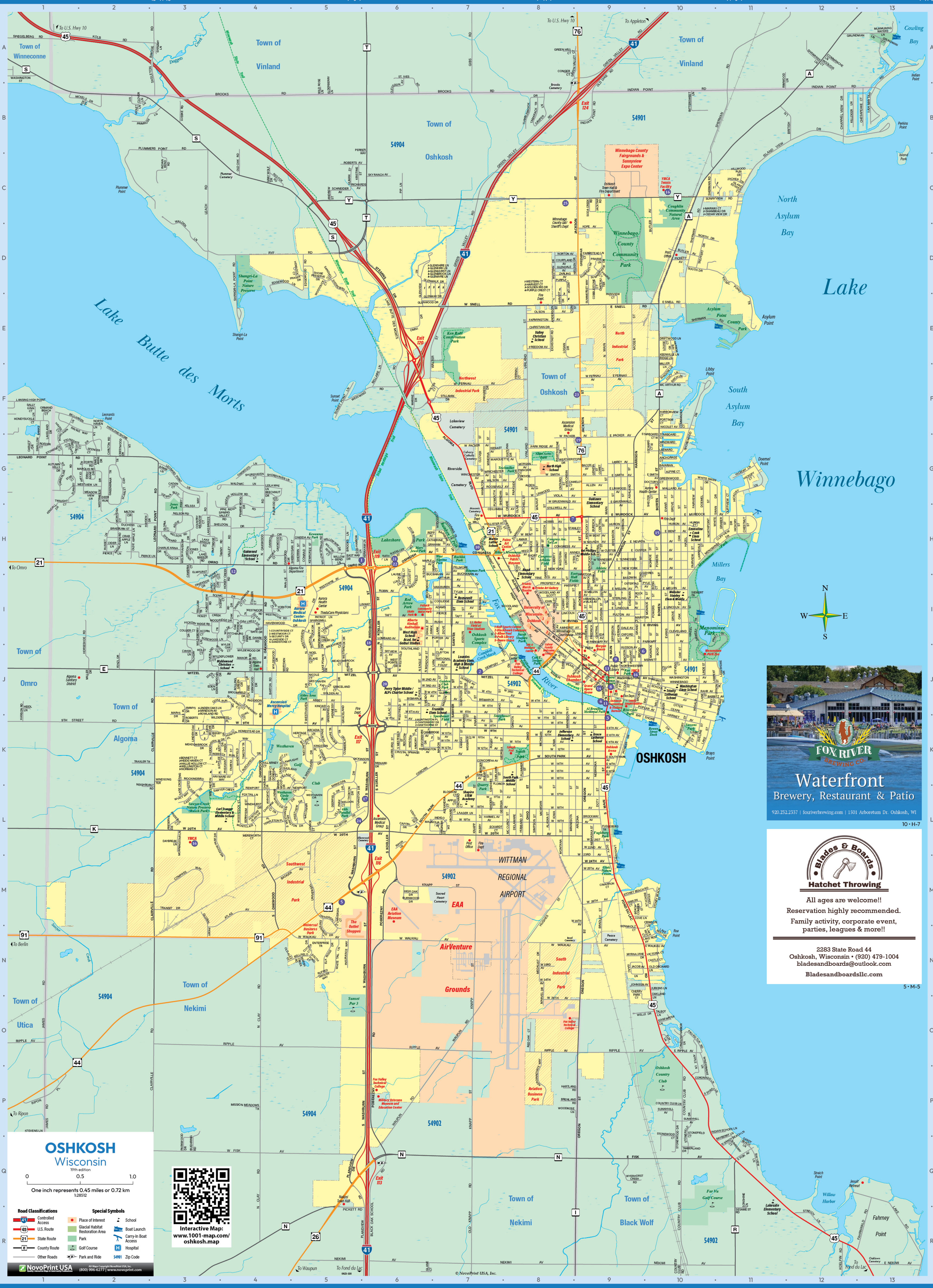

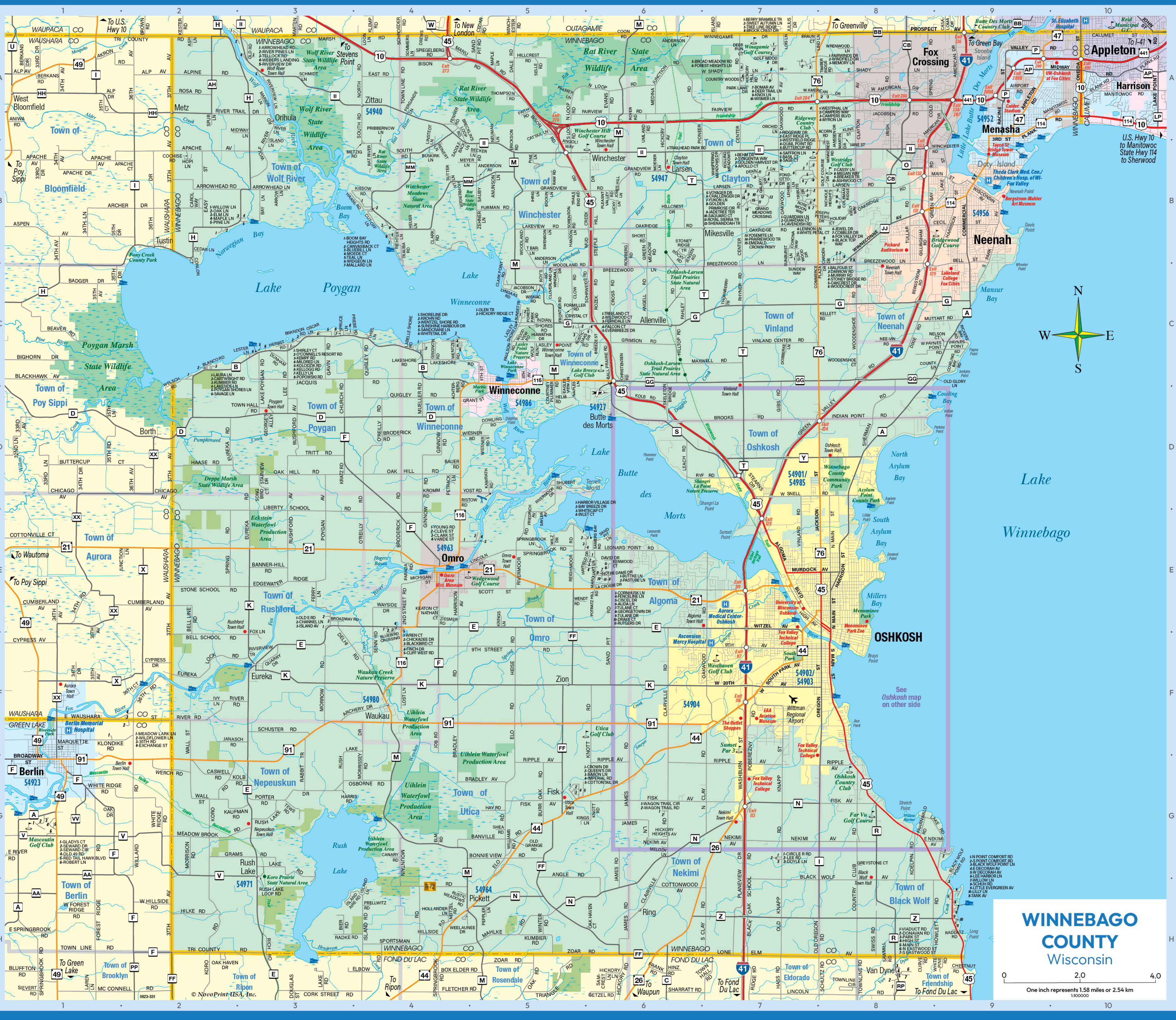

Attractions For All Ages

Oshkosh attracts more than 1 million people each year to attend music festivals, events and an international fly-in convention.

Annual events that attract visitors and residents alike include the Waterfest concert series from June through August; the Mis Wisconsin Pageant in June; Life's Christmas Musical in July; EAA AirVenture at the end of July; the Winnebago County Fair in August; Holiday Parade in November; and the Celebration of Lights kick-off to the holidays in November. Oshkosh also hosts a monthly Gallery Walk in downtown Oshkosh and a weekly Farmer's Market throughout the year.

The renovated Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel & Convention Center re-opened in April 2013, making downtown Oshkosh an even more attractive place to visit. The Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel & Convention Center is located on North Main Street and the Fox River.

The Oshkosh Arena features seating for up to 3,500 for games and 4,000 for events and is a dedicated place to visit. The Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel & Convention Center is located on North Main Street and the Fox River.

A Historical Perspective

The fur trade brought the first European settlers to what is now Oshkosh in 1682.

In the summer of 1835, Webster Shuler became Oshkosh's first settler and soon established a trading post, tavern and inn. Only three years later, the community was home to a dedicated doctor. The city was later named Oshkosh after a Menominee Indian chief.

Despite the thriving fur trade, it was the lumber industry that fueled Oshkosh's development. Oshkosh became a city in 1855, and entrepreneurs such as Phileas Sawyer, the Morgans, the Paines and others made their fortunes in lumber. The great Chicago fire of 1871 created a boom in Oshkosh's lumber trade, as much of the lumber used to rebuild Chicago was produced by Oshkosh sawmills. At that time, Oshkosh became known as "Sawdust City."

Oshkosh and the surrounding area boast an abundance of sights and sounds for residents and visitors to discover and enjoy. The city is on the western shore of Lake Winnebago and is bordered by the Fox River and Lake Butte des Morts. Lake Winnebago, the largest freshwater lake within a U.S. state, was carved from the same limestone formation that created the Niagara Falls. These waterways that once provided transportation for explorers and the power for sawmills are still a vital part of the community, only now they are used for recreation.

A Place For All Tastes

The city caters to every taste, including the arts and the outdoors. Four museums, the Arts Center & Gardens, the Oshkosh Public Museum, Military Veterans Museum and Education Center, and the EAA Aviation Museum take visitors back in time. The Oshkosh Public Museum houses a diverse collection of objects representing the people and environment of Oshkosh and the surrounding area. The great Chicago fire of 1871 created a boom in Oshkosh's lumber trade, as much of the lumber used to rebuild Chicago was produced by Oshkosh sawmills. At that time, Oshkosh became known as "Sawdust City."

Fun For All Seasons

Oshkosh offers a variety of recreational activities that are enjoyed every day of the city's four seasons.

Oshkosh's Polk Community Water Park features two large slides and a Lazy River. Oshkosh's parks are sites for warm weather activities, such as roller skating, walking and other outdoor fun. Children run, jump and play in the 300,000-square-foot Oshkosh Community Playground, known as "Little Oshkosh" that was recently reopened in the Spring of 2020. Oshkosh's largest park, Menominee Park, also features a zoo full of land and water animals.

The Winnebago County Community Park, a 270-acre site, is the far northern section of the city and includes shelters with playground equipment, ball diamonds, a soccer complex, an archery range, a rugby field, tennis courts, an exercise course, picnic shelters, two fishing lakes, a swimming lake and a dog park.

The WINNEBAGO TRAIL, a 14.3-mile section that runs from Oshkosh to the Winnebago County line, is used for bicyclists, hikers, horseback riders, joggers and snowmobilers. Almost four miles of the trail weaves into Oshkosh and is used for hiking and bicycling. The Tribal Heritage Crossings of the WINNEBAGO State Recreation Trail, which spans the entire length

of the Lake Butte des Morts Bridge, opened in October 2013. The new crossway trail features a multi-use trail, 13 seasonal, Native American kiosks, fishing access, three overpasses dedicated to Earth, Fire and Water, and artwork dedicated to the rich culture and history of Oshkosh.

Oshkosh offers an assortment of courses in and around Oshkosh. Public courses include Ulica Golf Club, Westwood Golf Club, Fox Valley Golf Course, Lake Geneva Golf Club in Winnebago and Wedgewood Golf Course in Omro. The Oshkosh County Club offers 18 holes of golf and fine dining that is now open to the public.

Oshkosh's extensive waterways provide hours of enjoyment for fishing, boating, water skiing, fishing and ice fishing. Oshkosh hosts the largest ice fishing tournament, Battle on Bago. There is a winter and summer edition. Indoor fun is abundant at the Oshkosh YMCA. There are canoeing and west-side locations. The downtown location finished a new addition in 2017 which included an aquatic center, sauna and steam room, an indoor track and more.

If reading, research or studying is your pleasure, the Oshkosh Public Library is the place to go. The library offers children's programming, a genealogy collection, home delivery service, and a local history section.
